Meeting

The next meeting of the Kingdom Philatelic Association will be 7:00 p.m. Thursday, November 20, 2014 at the **Callaway Electric Coop Entergy Center**.

This month's circuits include 2 books of British North America, 1 book of France, 2 of Austria, 1 of Liechtenstein and 1 of Great Britain. There is one topical book with fish and ships. The rest are an assortment of U.S. stamps, including 3 with revenues.

Special Delivery



Special delivery service began Oct. 1, 1885, and offered same-day delivery of any letter or article received at a participating post office. The service was discontinued in 1997.

Linn's feature article; Stamp Market Tips recently discussed the 10c special delivery variety with the Messenger on a Bicycle. There are two major varieties of this stamp, E10 and E11.

It is interesting to note that the value of a mint copy of the E10 in the new 2015 catalog is \$320, the same as in my 2008 catalog. A used copy has increased in value from \$45 to \$50 though.

We looked at these stamps along with copies of E8 and E9 when we were studying watermarks and perforations. We saw the big difference in value that these characteristics can make. The Linn's article also indicates the need to watch for stamps that have been re-perforated.

Tidbits

The 20th right side up Jenny pane has been reported found in Ohio. That leaves 80 yet to be found.

The 1856 British Guiana One-Cent Magenta will be going on exhibit at the Smithsonian in April 2015. If you are going to be in Washington, D.C, you will want to stop by see it. It will be there for 3 years.

The 16th edition of the Scott Errors catalog is now on sale for \$39.95.
